Information for group leaders, campus ministers and leaders of young people attending Ignite Launch





OVERVIEW

What is Ignite Launch?

Ignite Launch is a one-day experience at Dreamworld where all young people, regardless of their faith level or background are invited to come and have an experience of Jesus, amongst the fun of a day at a theme park. During the day, delegates are free to roam throughout Dreamworld, experience the thrill of the rides, shows and catch up with some of the Ignite Youth crew who will be holding chill-out sessions throughout the day. After the park closes, Ignite Launch officially begins with dinner in the park. This is followed by an epic dance party featuring pumping beats, a live band, and inspirational guest speaker.

Ignite Launch is one of Ignite Youth's major events, it was the result of a dream back in 2014 to meet young people where they are at- physically and spiritually- and is the perfect entry point event for high schoolers and young adults. As an unprecedented event within youth ministry, young people experience both the thrill of Australia's largest theme park, alongside the genuine community and faith of a youth ministry event. It is an opportunity to hang out with their friends and make some new ones. We guarantee this will be an experience they won't forget anytime soon!

Finally, Ignite Launch is a **drug and alcohol-free event**. As Dreamworld is open to the public (10am- 5pm) attendees are free to come and go throughout the park, similar to a normal day at Dreamworld. However, once the park is closed and Ignite Launch begins, delegates are kept within the confines of Dreamworld and cannot leave without being escorted by a youth leader, parent, group leader or security guard.

SCHEDULE

Launch General Timetable

The schedule below is an example of what happens throughout the day at Dreamworld. There are a spread of different activities, meet-ups and tours to ensure every person feels part of the day, regardless if they've come alone or as part of a group. Up till 5pm, the activites are optional, but offer opportunities for different groups of people to meet up, pairing the thrill seekers, socialites or those who want someting more chilled out. When the park closes at 5pm, everyone gathers and continues the night activities as a large group, starting off with a catered dinner and followed by a Dance Party & Live Music in the Exhibition Centre.

6:00pm Dance Party & Live Music in the Exhibition Centre

8:15pm Home time! Everyone to leave through the front gate



DETAILS

Large Group Check-In Area

This year, large groups of 30+ will have a separate section to check into Dreamworld.

As your bus arrives at the bus terminal, your group leader can jump off and collect the box of name tags, tickets, booklets and meal vouchers for each person- as well as a check in list to make sure everyone is accounted for.

Check in times are from 9:15am and will close at 10am (unless we have been notified). If your group is going to be running late, please call Michael Adams on 0434 026 894.

Meals

Ignite Launch is not catering lunch for delegates. There are plenty of vendors within Dreamworld that sell a range of food. Alternatively, bring your own lunch and snacks for during the day. The registration includes Dinner provided by Dreamworld before the Night Rally, from 5pm-6pm in the park. *Please let us know of any dietary requirements when registering.*

Bus Recommendations

If you are looking for a bus for transport to and from Dreamworld with your group, we recommend Express Coach Lines. We often use Express Coaches for our Summer Camp and Conference buses. They offer small people movers to large coaches, and their information can be found online.

Photography

Ignite Youth has multiple photographers and videographers on site at Dreamworld to photograph every part of the day. So, feel free to leave the photos up to us, and enjoy your day at Dreamworld with your group. All our photos will be up on our Facebook after the event, however if you would like the originals, feel free to contact us.

Are there ATM machines at Dreamworld?

Dreamworld accepts most debit and credit cards. There are various ATM's through out the park. We recommend you use cash to purchase food and drink.

Where do I leave my bags?

Coin-operated lockers are available for hire for \$10.00 for a large size locker for the day. Lockers are located at various points through the park.

Once Ignite Launch has finished where do we get picked up from?

Ignite Launch's night rally will finish at 8:15pm, which is held in the Exhibition Centre, at the front of the park. Due to the park being closed, we encourage group leaders and parents organise to meet their students/children at the front gate, where all delegates will be escorted by Ignite Launch leaders after the end of the rally. As other events sometimes run throughout the park at the same time, Dreamworld is strict in it's security, which means delegates are unable to leave before 8:15pm.

Considering Bringing a Group?

Prices are subject to change at our discretion.

Dinner and Entry to Night Rally and Dance Party.

Group Consent Forms

Each Group should have a Consent & Indemnity Form according to the policies of their School, Parish or Organisation. Rather than doubling up on consent forms, Emmanuel Community will accept the consent forms of attending groups, providing they include the specific clauses listed on the following page in order to meet our requirements for registration. Feel free to copy and paste them across, and add any additional details you may require for your specific group, such as consent for transport, if you were to provide lunch or snacks, or other such examples.

These clauses can be adapted to suit the dual needs of Ignite Launch and your Group. An example might be a clause such as: (I understand that St Paul's College and Emmanuel Community may collect information about me....).

A blank copy of the consent form, including any edits or adaptations must be submitted to Ignite Youth prior to the event. Any variance required to the clauses above which changes the intention or effect of the clause should be advised to Emmanuel Community in writing.

Appendix: Required Clauses for Consent Form

Parental Consent: I give permission for my child to attend Ignite Launch in 2023, and to participate in activities he/she may choose while attending the event. [Emmanuel Community's Event Registration Conditions are available at www.igniteyouth.com/registrationconditions]

Indemnity: I understand that while every reasonable precaution will be undertaken to ensure the protection of me/my child, I hereby release Emmanuel Community, authorised Staff and Volunteers ("Emmanuel Community") from any and all liability in the event of any injury, accident, misfortune, damage or loss that may occur to me/my child and/or their property while present at the Ignite Launch. Further, I indemnify Emmanuel Community from and against all loss, including legal expenses, connected with or arising from any claims or demands in relation to my/my child's attendance at Ignite Launch, including leaving the venue without permission. I agree and understand that Emmanuel Community reserves the right to exercise discretion to refuse to register any delegate upon medical and/or other grounds without providing a detailed reason for doing so.

Medical Treatment Consent: I declare that I have passed on the correct information regarding my child's medical condition/s. I give permission for Emmanuel Community to obtain emergency medical, hospital or ambulance assistance and/or treatment for me/my child at any time they consider necessary. I understand that every effort will be made for myself to be notified before instituting such procedures. I acknowledge that I will be liable for any medical, hospital or ambulance expense incurred in my/my child's treatment, and I agree to pay those expenses. Unless I have otherwise advised Emmanuel Community in writing, I give permission for Paracetamol to be administered to my child, at the discretion of the Ignite Launch First Aid officers.

Privacy Declaration: I understand that Emmanuel Community may collect information about me/my child in accordance with their Privacy Policy, and that this information may be disclosed to certain parties it engages to organise the event. I consent to these details being used by Emmanuel Community, and other host organisations where applicable, for the promotion of future events and resources via post, phone, email and SMS. I can elect to have my details removed from their database at any time.

Media Release: I understand that Ignite Launch will be captured in photographs, video and audio, and that Emmanuel Community reserves the right to use this material for promotional purposes or other resources. I understand I must advise Emmanuel Community in writing if I do not give permission for images of my child to be used.
